Theoretical background

Given the main objective of this paper – identifying the relationship between Social Representation and Social Boundaries, when in love, we are considering as a theoretical background this three important concepts:

Study no. 1

The Social Representation of Love:

N = 250 Criterias: •Gender (*M*/*F*) •Nationality (*Romanian / Other*) •Economical status (*Rich / Poor*) •Religious confession (*Orthodox / Catholic*)

Methodology – Triangulation (Apostolidis, 2006)

- Complex free association task
- Semi directive interview.

- We expect to find differences between subjects, given the criteria of selection. The variable gender will probably be the most obvious in terms of differences.
- Probably the R.S of women will be more romantic and that of men will be more physically orientated

Study no. 2:

Research on a movie database: romance / drama

- 1930 1950
- 1960 1980
- 1990 2010

N = 60

(images and subtitles)

* Establish the way we can use the posters given the fact that they have a specificity of the period that they were released.



- As interested as it seems, we do not consider that the movies will influence the social representation of love among real subjects.
- We expect the movies to provide a more idealistic / surreal image of love (happy ending, overcoming the boundaries, exaggerated sadness, etc.)



Identifying the relationship between SR and SB: is love subjective to different social boundaries?

Methodology:

- Implicit Association Test (2 sets of stimulus love and boundaries)
- Probably doubled by a questionnaire Likert type
