many Romanian universities.

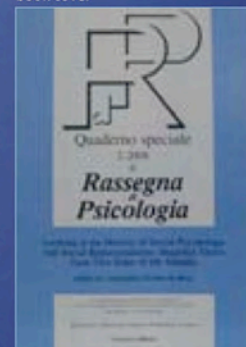

Since 1995 a series of 14 editions of the European Ph.D. on S.R. & C. International Summer Schools has been organized implying international collective mobility of both invited professors and research trainees, primarily, but not exclusively reserved to those enrolled into the European Ph.D. in order to improve exchanges with a selected number of participants of any countries enrolled in other doctorates in social sciences (see the mobility flows below).

Together with the 12th International LAB Meeting, these Summer Schools have provided an opportunity to obtain advanced academic and technical skills for research.



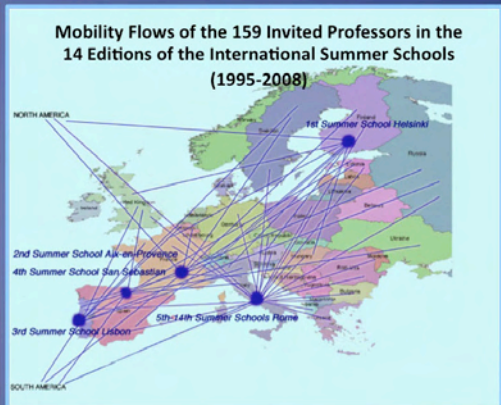
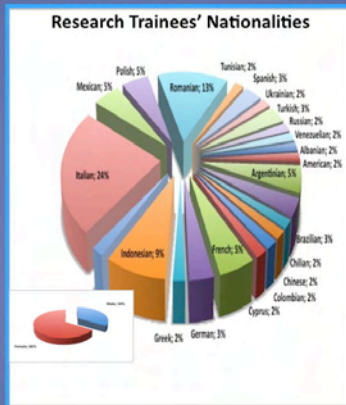
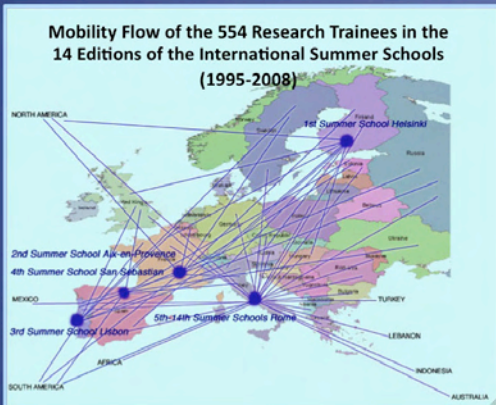
