

FP7-PEOPLE-ITN project

Our "FP7-PEOPLE-2010-ITN" - SoReComTheNet EuPhD project proposal, submitted last December to the European Commission, has received an excellent evaluation and has passed all evaluation thresholds, obtaining a mark of 82,40 (the threshold was 70,00).

Due to the limited budget available, the Research Executive Agency must also take account of the strategic objectives of the programme, as well as the overall balance of the proposals and new networks to be funded. Therefore, only 7 out of the 863 presented proposals have been funded in the field of Social Sciences.

Despite the many strengths of the proposal acknowledged in the evaluation by the EC (good training capacities, incorporation of non-EU partners, appropriate management policy, efficient networking, exploitation of synergies and complementarities among partners, very good scientific quality of the research programme with an appropriate methodology, very good training on supra-disciplinary fields, international mobility, use of IT tools, etc.), the project has unfortunately not been included among the seven projects funded in the field of social sciences.
