Outcome of the Sapienza Call for Applications to fellowships and admission of Foreign Nationals Educated Abroad Academic Year 2010-2011

On 23 April 2010, University of Rome "La Sapienza" published the call for application n.403, offering twenty three year full-time postgraduate PhD positions with fellowship for attaining the degree of "Dottore di Ricerca" (PhD) in its Doctoral Schools. The call was open to non Italian citizens who have obtained an academic qualification abroad by a non-Italian institution which satisfies the entrance requirements for admission to a Doctoral Programme

One of these fellowships was dedicated to the PhD School "Sapienza Co-ordination Programme for Joint European/International Doctorates", which includes 4 PhD programmes: European PhD on Social Representations and Communication, European PhD in Socio-Economic and Statistical Studies, International PhD in Astrophysics and European PhD in Cognitive Neuro-Plasticity and Rehabilitation.

The PhD School received 56 candidatures, divided as follow: 33 candidates from 27 countries for the European PhD on Social Representations and Communication; 12 candidates from 11 countries for the European PhD in Cognitive Neuro-Plasticity and Rehabilitation; 9 candidates from 9 countries for the European PhD in Socio-Economic and Statistical Studies; 2 candidates from 2 countries for the International PhD in Astrophysics.

The fellowship was awarded to Ms Haoxing Wang from China, who applied for the European PhD on Social Representations and Communication.

ERASMUS IP project

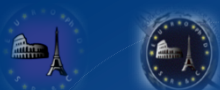

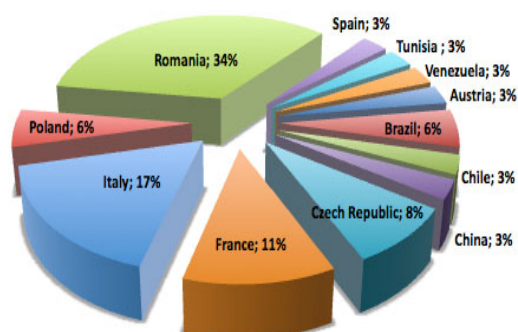

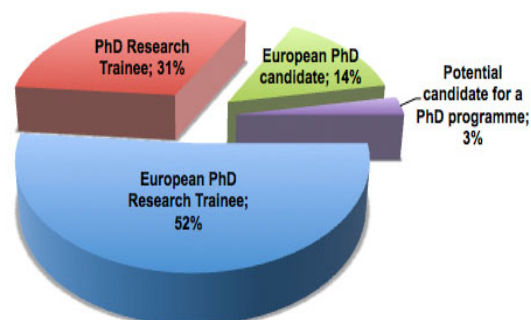

Participants to the 16th International Summer School according to Nationality



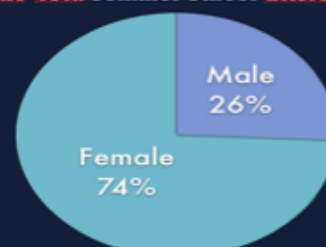
Participants to the 16th International Summer School according to status



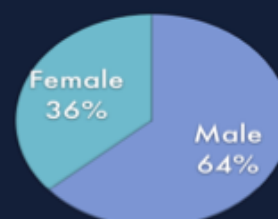
Teaching Staff according to nationality
