V° Romania National Conference of Psychology 23-26 September, Iasi



This year (2010), the Faculty of Psychology and Education Sciences of Iasi has the honour to organise the Romanian National Conference on Psychology. It's not by chance that Iasi chose this date to host the conference. In 2010, the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University, the first institution of higher education in Romania, celebrates 150 years from its establishment. In addition, the beginning of the university education in psychology in Iasi precedes the establishment of the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University. Psychology was one of the philosophical disciplines taught at "Academia Mihailean" and the Socola Semina. Once with the establishment of the University in 1860, the first university courses in (didactic) psychology and pedagogy were held by Simion Sornutiu.

After December 1989, the pedagogy and psychology departments were reestablished within the Faculty of Philosophy. In 1997, a separation from the Faculty of Philosophy took place, justified both from an administrative and epistemological point of view, through the establishment of the Faculty of Psychology and Education Sciences.

The conference foresees the participation of well-known guest speakers such as: Prof. Dr. James Maddux (USA), Prof. Dr. Craig McCarthy (Australia), Prof. Dr. Annamaria de Rosa (Italy), Theo Peeters (Holland), Hilde De Clercq (Holland), Terry Krupa (Canada), Debbie Radloff-Gabriel (Canada) and Simona Sanislav (Canada). During the event, Prof. Dr. Annamaria de Rosa will be conferred the title of **Doctor Honoris Causa** of the University A.I. Cuza of Iasi.
