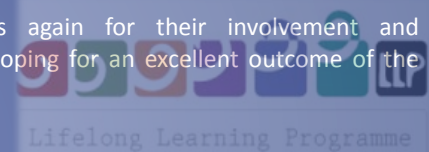
Participation in the LLP Program: Fourth Project submitted on March 13th 2009

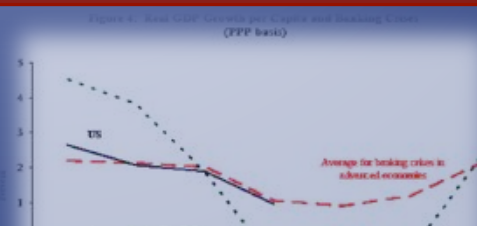

"Mass Psychology and Stock Market: heterogeneous agents, Investors and Media"

Developing a previous empirical contribution, Annamaria de Rosa has activated a large international research program in different European countries (Austria, France, Italy, U.K.) and Continents (Europe, U.S., and Asia) together with a multi-disciplinary research team composed of Social Psychologists, Experts in Communication Sciences, Economists, Neuro-Economists, specialists of the Stock and Financial Market, in co-operation with national and international non Academic partners, such as different Bank organisations directly involved in the current international financial crisis.

On January 31st 2009 the first brainstorming meeting of the research team was held at the European PhD Research Centre and multi-media Lab in Rome in connection with colleagues from China via Web-Auditorium.
