Doctoral education has been undergoing a dramatic change in the last decade in Europe. However, whereas the need for targeted investments in the personal and professional development of PhD candidates, support structures such as doctoral schools, and higher quality of scientific supervision are widely accepted, a proper investment in the professional development of administrative staff needed to support the overall endeavor, is rather neglected. Thus the framework changed without taking the needs of a professional administration fully into account.

The **PRIDE project** - funded by the European Commission DG EAC through the Lifelong Learning Programme - aims at elaborating an alternative approach to administration in the area of doctoral education.
