### Meeting of the SoReCom Joint-IDP Sapienza Supervisory Board September 15, 2016

The Sapienza Supervisory Board (Project Leader Annamaria de Rosa, Bruno Mazzara, Giovanna Leone, Mauro Sarrica and the invited member dr. Laura Dryjanska), held a joint meeting during the 13 ICSR in Marseilles aimed at:

- a. Sharing an **update view** of the current status of the project
- b. Informing about the **approved abstracts** submitted to forthcoming international conferences with active participation of the ESRs at individual level
- c. Deciding to send an invitation to the Fellows to meet the next deadlines for submitting the thesis outline, in order to be ready to achieve the challenge of the final dissertation in agreement with the 3rd year plans and time management. It was decided to exceptionally extend the deadline of the submission of the final version of the thesis and of the short article already approved by the main supervisor and Sapienza co-tutor from March 31 to April 18, 2017. 
