




So.Re.Com. Joint-IDP: activity report for months 46-47 (July-August 2017)




40th Annual Scientific meeting of the International Society of Political Psychology




The main conference theme this year was **REVISITING CORE THEMES OF TYRANNY, INTERGROUP RELATIONS AND LEADERSHIP**

18th General Meeting of the European Association of Social Psychology


Granada, Spain 5-8 July, 2017


18th General Meeting of the European Association of Social Psychology



Visit to China of the SoReCom Joint-IDP Project Leader at **Zhejiang University** in **Hangzhou** (July 15-26, 2017)



Annamaria Silvana de Rosa visited China for 12 days for an **Erasmus +** program exchange between **Sapienza University** and **Zhejiang University**, in **Hangzhou**, where she met prof. **Jianhong Ma** (Vice Head of the Department of Psychology and Behavioral Sciences) and other professors, PhD and Master students.

The visit was aimed at research and institutional collaboration exchanges and also included exploration at the campus of high tech labs for experiments on virtual 3D reality in several domains (driving conducts, urban planning guided by environmental concern for the "ideal city", etc.). It has been an occasion to discover research lines developed by the Chinese colleagues of great potentiality for an openness to social representations, to disseminate our **SoReCom Joint-IDP** main outcomes and to explore opportunities of mutual collaboration in the future within the framework of the **European/International Joint PhD on Social Representations and Communication**.


We are pleased to announce that the

Sixth International Colloquium

“Discourse, representations, argumentation”

took place in **Rio de Janeiro**, Brazil

from the 16th to 18th of August 2017



“Different perspectives on the same issues: discourse and interdisciplinarity” is the theme of the upcoming Sixth International Colloquium “Discourse, Representations, Argumentation”, sponsored by **Communalis** - International Communication and Natural Logic Society.

Reaching consensus on the status of discursive objects with regards to language and its relationships with thought processes through communication seems quite unlikely. The surprising crossing of multiple methods of analysis in many non-mathematical disciplines that came to light since the nineteenth century (sociology, psychology, education, communication, language sciences, etc.) only further complicates the resolution of this issue. However, one must admit that most approaches – rooted in the problem of inter, multi or trans-disciplinarity – converge towards the core question of making sense of 'discourse' which, on the one hand, gradually moves away from its attachment to the notion of 'text' as being engendered by the verbal-oral couple and, on the other, go on the direction of discursive multi-medialization. This is the complex debate that Communalis wants to encourage during the 2017 colloquium.

granted by the **University of Quilmes**, Buenos Aires Argentina
on August 24, 2017
with a conference on "**Representaciones sociales y memoria**",
one of her main interest and contribution to our scientific domain



La Universidad Nacional de Quilmes (UNQ) entregó el título de Doctor Honoris Causa a Denise Jodelet, investigadora social francesa. La distinción fue otorgada por el rector de la UNQ, Alejandro Vilas, y el vicerrector, Alfredo Alfonso. Luego, brindó una conferencia magistral titulada "Contribución de las representaciones sociales al estudio del conocimiento y del mantenimiento del pasado histórico".

El Rector destacó que "el reconocimiento a Denise Jodelet implica una invitación a formar parte de nuestra casa, de nuestra comunidad" y que su aporte académico significa una contribución para la comprensión del contexto social y el trabajo en territorio.

Por su parte, Jodelet agradeció el reconocimiento y remarcó que "el título me brinda una de las mayores alegrías: ser parte de ustedes y establecer un vínculo de intercambio". En su exposición, a través de ejemplos históricos, abordó el concepto de memoria colectiva, su vínculo con la ética y su "uso profiláctico, como barrera de defensa ante un pasado negativo". También se refirió a la relación existente entre la historia y las representaciones sociales. "No se trata de defender la identidad grupal o nacional, sino de preservar la verdad en el recuerdo auténtico y sin tapujos del pasado", concluyó.

Jodelet es Doctora de Estado por el gobierno francés y se especializa en el estudio de las representaciones sociales. Se destacan sus contribuciones en el área de salud mental, psicología social y memoria. Además, su preocupación por reivindicar los espacios de investigación social en la región latinoamericana le han valido múltiples reconocimientos académicos.


