In the very rich photo-gallery of the 34 events organised since 1995 within the training activities of the **European/International Joint PhD in Social Representations and Communication**, above a photo of Jorge during his lecture "**Social Representations and Social Identity Theory**" given at the 3rd International PhD Summer School on "**Social Representations Theory: historical roots, articulation and development**" held in Lisbon on 6-15 September 1997.

Jorge has also participated in other scientific events, including the **5th International PhD Summer School "Developing European Doctoral Training"**, held in Rome, Italy, in 1999, on June, 5-11.

Among other **memories of institutional relevance**.....
it is difficult to forget that the initiative launched by A.S. de Rosa for creating the *European/International Joint PhD in Social Representations and Communication* took the first shape exactly in Lisbon during the **EASP conference** (September 19, 1993) and translated into action thanks to the **EC project under the Erasmus CDA schema in 1993: the first of a very long history of successful approved projects**

It was in the the meeting convened during the 1993 Lisbon conference that **Serge Moscovici, Rob Farr, Gerard Duveen, Jorge Jesuino, Klaus Helkama** and other representatives of the 13 Universities (later 17, currently 24 in 16 countries around the world) decided to trust in the **Annamaria de Rosa's** innovative idea to design the first European networked PhD and to share efforts to implement it three years later in 1996 (enlarged in 2006 beyond the EU borders as *European/International Joint PhD*: <http://www.euophd.net/background>)

Among these Academic Institutions **ISCTE** was in the front row, thanks not only the institutional commitment by **Jorge Jesuino**, who was able to obtain the first approval and recognition of the joint signature of the degree, but also **Jorge Vala** and **Maria Benedicta Monteiro's** scientific interest for developing social representations theory, originating next generation of scholars at **ISCTE-IUL** who continue to contribute in the field. Just evoking these memories, it was very sad to receive the announcement that **Luisa Lima** and **Jorge Vala** transmitted to the EASP members of the passing of **Maria Benedicta Monteiro** on the evening of November, 9th (see the **Obituary** in the next slides).



Ciao Maria Benedicta from all of us



It is with an immense sadness that we inform you of the passing of **Maria Benedicta Monteiro** on the evening of November, 9th, 2017.

Maria was a social psychologist admired by her students and an irreplaceable colleague and friend.

Throughout her career, Maria was able to inspire her students and develop strong national and international bonds and research networks. Maria is a prominent figure and one of the founders of developmental social psychology.

Her work on aggression, intergroup conflict, discrimination, inequalities, negotiation and intergroup cooperation was enthusiastically received and discussed within our community. Her research has always been guided by the hypothesis that a social-developmental approach is paramount to a better understanding of discrimination and social inequalities and their underlying factors such as social status, dominance relations, social norms and socio-cognitive processes.

A strong sign of the wide scope and reach of her work can be found in the book **"The Social Developmental Construction of Violence and Intergroup Conflict"** (Springer), a festschrift organized by former students and colleagues. The Portuguese community of psychologists recognized her role in psychology by awarding her the **Portuguese Association of Psychology Career Award** in 2010.

Maria's service to **ISCTE-IUL**, the University she worked at for over 25 years, including serving as the Chair of the Department of Social and Organizational Psychology, was admired by students and colleagues. But her activities and outreach were far beyond her work at the University. She gave hundreds of conferences in schools for both teachers and young students on multicultural relations and was a **consultant for the Ministry of Education of Portugal for issues of Multiculturalism and intercultural education**. Maria was cosmopolitan, a traveller who knew no borders, and a defender of diversity and freedom. For all these reasons, her wake was held at the **Ecumenic Center of the city of Lisbon**.



will take place at the University of Roma Tre
8-13 July 2018 - Rome, Italy

The theme of the 25th **IAPS 2018 Rome Conference** follows coherently with the themes of the last Conferences in Lund/Alnarp, Timisoara, Glasgow and Leipzig. The theme of the last IAPS conference underlined the importance of the everyday life contexts to understand people-environment relations. In Rome 2018 we will go further along this thematic stream, and focus on the transition processes needed to achieve more sustainable societies at the global, regional and local level. The theme we propose is therefore referred to the “**Transitions to sustainability, lifestyles and human wellbeing: cultural, environmental and political challenges**”.

To achieve a significant shift towards a **more sustainable relation between humans and their daily life environments, the need of a radical lifestyle change is increasingly recognised, at the scientific, political and public opinion level**. The transition to a low-carbon, more inclusive and open society has already started, under the push of different democratic instances and driving forces. To sustain this transition, and to manage the related cultural, economic and political processes, people-environment studies have a fundamental role to play. The integrated contribution of the different scientific disciplines, with the diversity of approaches, theories, and methods that are traditionally hosted within the **IAPS community**, represents an opportunity and a tool to understand this dynamics and, in turn, to help decision makers in improving policy and governance instruments to face these challenges.

Therefore, the conference works will focus around these issues, and will try to address **important questions in this domain**, such as, for example:

How can we realise transitions towards sustainability in the real world?

What are drivers, triggers, instruments – but also the obstacles and limits to these transitions? Which is the role of the key actors and networks to advance sustainability transitions in practice: individuals, groups, communities, and institutions? How can scientific results impact societal challenges in practice, and how can we provide effective and evidence-based knowledge about the fundamental role of people-environment studies in this process? What concrete examples and best-practices can we look at, for helping sustainability transitions towards a low-carbon and more inclusive society? Which role can real-world and laboratory experiments play to change our lifestyles and increase our pro-environmental behaviour?



We are pleased to announce that the *24th Edition of the European/International Joint PhD International Summer School* will held in *June 2018*, from Monday 18 to Friday 22.

Enhancing inter-institutional collaboration supported by the *Erasmus teaching staff mobility* toward Sapienza University of Rome, Professors *Pascal Moliner* (Université de Montpellier III, France) and *Inna Bovina* (Moscow State University of Psychology and Education, Russia) have already confirmed their participation with an intensive program entitled “*SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY OF PICTURES: Empirical studies from the social representations perspective*” aimed at presenting a set of theoretical, methodological and empirical elements about the links between social representations and pictures (photographs, drawings, advertising, propaganda).

5. *Collective memory and propaganda. Empirical studies.*

Prof. *Annamaria de Rosa* (Sapienza University of Rome) will contribute to the scientific program presenting a *series of iconic-based techniques* that she has created and employed in empirical research programs on different topics, illustrating theoretical and methodological implications of the “*modelling paradigmatic approach*” to Social Representations developed by her.
